Dr. Fielden received his Bachelor of Architecture: Design Option from Texas Tech University; he has a Masters of Education: Administration degree from UNLV and his Architecture Doctorate from the University of Hawaii, Manoa, a Carnegie I Research Institution.

Dr. Fielden is a past member of the national Board of Directors of the American Institute of Architects; he served as the national Secretary-Treasurer of the National Architectural Accrediting Board, and is a past national President of the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards, the NCARB. He is only one of eight architects ever elected to serve in leadership roles within these three prestigious organizations.

Through his leadership positions, Dr. Fielden has represented his profession and the people of the United States of America as an official trade representative; and, in this role he has helped negotiate international professional registration arrangements and agreements between the United States and Canada, the United States and Great Britain, the United States and the origins of the European Union, and the United States and China.

Fielden has practiced architecture and urban planning in southern Nevada since 1967. He is the recipient of numerous planning and design awards, including international honors for his contributions to planning, architecture, urban design and resource conservation. He is a popular commentator and speaker on issues impacting the environment and sustainability, and on topics relative to building and strengthening the qualities of community life.
